- 1. Find a MouseKeyDo® provider.** A MouseKeyDo provider is a health and safety professional—usually a licensed physical therapist, occupational therapist, occupational health nurse or a physician—who has been trained in the proper use of the MouseKeyDo System. You can find a conveniently located provider using our [Provider Finder](#).
  
- 2. Get a prescription for the MouseKeyDo System from the treating physician.** Refer the physician to the MouseKeyDo website for information about the system if necessary. A [prescription form](#) can be downloaded. We have also included an additional [prescription form with "Bay Area" training providers](#) listed at the bottom. Please use whichever form is most convenient.
  
- 3. Get the patient's insurance information.** [Patient's insurance form](#)
  
- 4. If indicated, your treating physician will order the MouseKeyDo System Equipment or Training by submitting the prescription form to the insurance carrier.**

Please allow two weeks for insurance authorization and shipping of the MouseKeyDo® System Equipment.

The treating physician can monitor the patient's progress using the training logs in the manual.
